[This is the latest in a series of procedural updates. These updates deal with specific MVD procedures and practices. Managers and Supervisors should consistently distribute the updates to all personnel and integrate them into regular information and training sessions.]

New Boy Scouts of America Centennial, Child Adoption Awareness and New Mexico Highlands University (NMHU) Special Plates are now available.

The Boy Scouts and Adoption Awareness plates are available with a \$12.00 fee for initial issuance of each plate, in addition to regular motor vehicle registration fees.

The purpose of the new "Adopt a Child" plate is to promote awareness of the need for adoption of children in New Mexico.

This new plate can be ordered using the Application for Child Adoption Awareness Plate (MVD-10101).



The Boy Scouts of America Centennial Plate commemorates the centennial of the Boy Scouts of America, which was founded 100 years ago last month (on February 8, 1910).

The BSA plate can be ordered using the Application for Boy Scouts of America Centennial Plate (MVD-10103).



The New Mexico Highlands University (NMHU) Special Plate is the sixth collegiate plate now available using the revised Application for Collegiate Registration Plate (MVD-11322).



The new NMHU plate is available for \$37.00, due upon initial issuance and each registration renewal, in addition to regular motor vehicle registration fees. Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) of each \$37.00 fee collected for a collegiate plate is distributed to the educational institution.
