

## MVD Procedural Quick Update

**RE: Vehicle transaction fees**

*[This is the latest in a series of procedural updates. These updates deal with specific MVD procedures and practices. Managers and Supervisors should consistently distribute the updates to all personnel and integrate them into regular information and training sessions.]*

**A change has been made in MVD 2.0 to correct the fees charged when a duplicate title is issued with changes.**

**In the past, MVD 2.0 has incorrectly charged the customer for two transactions. MVD 2.0 now correctly treats issuance of a duplicate title with changes as a single transaction. This has reduced the total fee charged from \$21.50 to \$16.50.**

Sec. 66-6-19, regarding vehicle transaction fees, defines a "transaction" to mean all operations necessary at one time with respect to one vehicle.

Until recently, when we issued a duplicate title with changes (i.e. add a name, change address, etc.) MVD 2.0 incorrectly charged administrative and transaction fees twice, once for the title and once for any changes. The amount charged to the customer included a basic duplicate title fee of \$11.50 plus a \$3.00 transaction fee and a \$2.00 administrative fee = \$16.50 for the duplicate title, plus another \$3.00 transaction fee and \$2.00 administrative fee = \$5.00 for the change, for a total of \$21.50.

That error has now been corrected in MVD 2.0, so that the customer now pays the correct amount – \$16.50 for a duplicate title, whether or not there are any changes.
