[This is the latest in a series of procedural updates. These updates deal with specific MVD procedures and practices. Managers and Supervisors should consistently distribute the updates to all personnel and integrate them into regular information and training sessions.]

Effective immediately, several fees have been corrected in MVD 2.0. These fees have been revised to accurately reflect the correct totals of base fees plus any applicable add-on fees.

The fees in the table below have now been changed to the new, corrected totals:

<u>Fees charged for</u>	<u>Old, incorrect total</u>	<u>New, corrected total</u>
Permit	\$7.00	\$10.00
Ignition Interlock License	\$53.00	\$63.00
Limited License	\$53.00	\$63.00
1-Year License (Medical)	\$10.00	\$10.50
H or X Endorsement (CDL Hazmat)	\$125.00	\$127.00

Two other changes have been made to ensure that total fees charged are reliably correct:

1. The \$15.00 add-on charge should now be correctly applied (added) to all permits and licenses issued to individuals moving to New Mexico from out of state.
2. There have been some problems in applying the pro rata license fee reduction for individuals age 72-75 who are applying for a new or renewal license. Those problems should now be fixed.
