[This is the latest in a series of procedural updates. These updates deal with specific MVD procedures and practices. Managers and Supervisors should consistently distribute the updates to all personnel and integrate them into regular information and training sessions.]

The City of Las Cruces special plate is now available for order by residents of Las Cruces, using the new Application for City of Las Cruces Plate form (MVD-10099).

Sec. 66-3-424.23 NMSA 1978 provides for issuance of a special City of Las Cruces registration plate to vehicle owners who are residents of Las Cruces, New Mexico.



The new plate is available only to residents of Las Cruces. When a person holding a special City of Las Cruces registration plate ceases to reside in Las Cruces, that person shall immediately remove the special City of Las Cruces registration plate from the vehicle; return it to the Motor Vehicle Division; and exchange it for another plate.

For purposes of plate issuance to residents of Las Cruces, the vehicle's current registration must show a Las Cruces (street or P.O. Box) address. No additional proof of residence is required.

The fee payable for the initial issuance of a special City of Las Cruces registration plate and for each subsequent renewal is thirty-seven dollars (\$37.00) in addition to regular vehicle registration fees. Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected for each registration plate shall be distributed to the city of Las Cruces Recreation Fund.
